By Kansas Statutes written notice shall be mailed to all owners of record of lands within the City of Marysville, located within at least 200 feet of area proposed to be altered. Notice shall also be mailed to all owners of record of lands within the Extra-Territorial Area of Marysville, located at least 1,000 feet of the area proposed to be altered.

By City Ordinance #1811 written notice shall be mailed to all owners of record of real property within 1,250 feet of the area proposed to be altered in neighborhoods wherein lots are zoned in SR Districts, this will allow them to address the Planning Commission with their opinions about proposed changes in zoning.

The notice shall include the same information as contained in the newspaper notice.
